10.30 am	Viewing of entries - judges circulating
11.00 am	Bring your own morning tea. Coffee & tea provided for adults.
12.00 pm	Presentation of certificates and prizes
12.30 pm	Pack up and clean up with everyone's help
12.45 pm	Bring your own picnic for a picnic in Rocket Park (adjacent)
1.30 pm	Hall closed (latest)

- ➔ Half a trestle table will be provided for each entry.
- ➔ Several appointed judges will circulate and talk to each entrant.
- ➔ Children are encouraged to stand beside their work for part of the morning to answer questions and explain their project to observers.
- ➔ A feedback sheet will be provided for judges' remarks. Visitors can also add their own comments so that each child takes away a whole sheet of valuable observations.
- ➔ Prizes will be awarded for a limited number of entries, as decided by the judges.
- ➔ Every entrant will receive a participation certificate.

**IMPORTANT:** Whilst the whole family is welcome, this is a long morning for littlies. Please note that childcare facilities are not available. For the safety of your children, others and the displays, **it is your responsibility** to supervise your family or make childcare arrangements.
